**Sub: Technical Education Quality Improvement Programme (TEQIP)
– Inclusion of 81 additional Institutions under Second Cycle**

Dear Sir/Madam,

This is to convey Ministry of Human Resource Development (vide Letter No. F. No. 16-12/2004-TS.VII dated November 03, 2004) approval for the initial fund allocation (as recommended by the Expert Committee) to the respective Programme institutions and SPFUs as per the details given in the enclosure. This approval is to enable the institutions selected under the Second Cycle from your State to start their respective project activities. The final Programme-life allocation will be intimated to you later subject to the approval of the National Selection Committee; there may be increase/decrease in the initial allocation for certain institutions.

In view of the above, the States are requested to take the following actions immediately:

1. Inform institutions about their inclusion in the Programme.
2. Allocate funds for expenditure during the current financial year (2004-05) as per their respective requirements for the current financial year.
3. Release the allocated funds to the institutions under intimation to the NPIU.
4. Monitor implementation of activities as prioritized by the institutions and indicated in their respective Concise Institutional Proposals.
5. Based on the suggested MOU in PIP, State Government may sign MOUs with respective Institutions and forward a copy to NPIU latest by November 30, 2004 (submission of the MOU to World Bank would determine the eligibility of the Institutions/States to seek reimbursement under the Programme).

The following activities are planned by NPIU in the next few weeks. Participation of SPFUs and the Second Cycle institutions is necessary in these activities. Details will be communicated to you soon.

1. Launch Workshop for all Second Cycle institutions and their concerned SPFUs.
2. During the Launch Workshop, the following activities will also be carried out:

P.T.O

- Fine tuning of Concise Institutional Proposals,
- Finalization of targets for Output Indicators,
- Firming up of network partners and network activities, and
- Fine tuning of activities under TDP and Services to Community.
