October 10 ~ Archdiocesan Celebration at Schoenstatt Center

There will be a diocesan-wide celebration on Sunday, October 10, at the Schoenstatt Center in Waukesha. A procession will begin at the entrance to the Schoenstatt Center at 3:15. A concelebrated Mass will begin at 4 p.m., and will conclude with a procession with the Holy Eucharist, to end at the chapel. There will be time for adoration and a reception hosted by the Schoenstatt community. Priests are invited to bring their own alb and stole if they wish to concelebrate.

Small Group Lenten Materials

Eucharist: Source and Summit of Life and Mission of the Church, a series of small group discussion materials, will be available to parishes for use during Lent. These materials will cover six sessions and will focus on:

- ~ the History of the Eucharist;
- ~ Liturgy of the Word: Introductory Rites;
- ~ Liturgy of the Word: Proclamation of the Word of God;
- ~ Liturgy of the Eucharist: Preparation and Eucharistic Narratives;
- ~ Communion and Dismissal Rite; and
- ~ Eucharistic Devotions.

The materials are being produced by the Archdiocese of Milwaukee and will be available for purchase from the Archdiocese. More information will be provided to parish leaders once all of the details have been finalized.

"Eucharist: Source and Summit of Life" Catechetical Conference

"Eucharist: Source and Summit of Life" is the theme for the catechetical conference that will be held October 13-15, 2005. The conference will offer education and formation for Catholic school faculties, catechetical parish leaders, ministers and catechists and faith formation opportunities for Catholic adults. The conference will focus on the theme of the Eucharist as the center of our spiritual lives.

A Mass on Sunday, October 16, 2005, at the Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist will mark the solemn conclusion of the Year of the Eucharist. Following the Mass, there will be exposition, followed by Evening Prayer and Benediction.
