# THE NATUROPATHIC PHYSICIAN

Naturopathic Physicians (N.D.s) attend a four-year professional medical degree program in naturopathic medicine. Studies concentrate on holistic and nontoxic approaches to therapy with strong emphasis on disease prevention and optimizing wellness. Graduates sit for professional board exams to become licensed as general practice naturopathic doctors within licensed states or as individual jurisdictions allow.

### CURRICULUM

The N.D. program incorporates advanced training in botanical medicine, homeopathic medicine, nutrition, acupuncture, oriental medicine, physical medicine, minor surgery and counseling. The curriculum offers a strong biomedical science foundation with anatomy, physiology, biochemistry and pathology along with physical, clinical and laboratory diagnosis, incorporating business practice management, pharmacology and pharmacognosy.

### INTEGRATIVE CLINICAL EDUCATION

Southwest College clinical education provides students with an integrative approach to medicine while encompassing traditional natural therapy philosophies and emphasizing the practical information necessary to establish a successful practice. In private practices, such as N.D., M.D. and D.O. offices and in local health care and hospital settings. Distinctive program elements include:
