This is a pivotal time in the history of medicine.

Physicians, researchers and health care professionals have come to recognize and embrace terms such as "alternative, complementary, and integrative" medicine. This translates into a true coalition of advanced conventional and naturopathic medicine.



Here are a few statistics that illustrate the demand for naturopathic medicine:

*42% of all Americans have used alternative medicine to address their health and wellness concerns."

"70% of Americans have tried or are currently using, at least one of the eight selected alternative medicines and, under the right circumstances, may be willing to try more."

The budget for the National Center of Complementary & Alternative Medicine (NCCAM) went from \$2 million in 1993 to \$50 million in 1999. (An increase of 2500%)¹

Americans spend more that \$27 billion on these therapies, exceeding out-of pocket spending for all U.S. hospitalizations.¹

A survey published in 1994 revealed that more than 60% of doctors from a wide range of specialties recommended alternative therapies to their patients at least once. The same study showed that 47% of those doctors used alternative therapies themselves.²
