 - Desktop number 1 in the US
- Drop Desktop
 - Focus resources on Enterprise Servers
- Fedora (now)=Redhat 9.0 + apt+gnome 2.4

Developer's DISTRO

Fedora is a developer's distro

What is Fedora - End User

- Many Users of Redhat 9.0
 - Ease use Install Upgrade Update
- Many programs to install
 - Openoffice
 - Mozilla
 - Gaim

What is Fedora - Developers

- Community based development
 - BENFIT- groups/organizations/universities
- As little or as much as you need
 - X
 - Server
- APT included
- Not re-inventing the wheel
 - Rpm's and tar's (standard)

Who's using it

- Developers want a community based distro over company based distro
- End users from Redhat 9.0
- New Linuxers (popularity)

Status Project

- Stable (stable!= 1.5 years old)
 - Based on Development from the community
 - Early stages
 - Community develops over time
 - 2.6 kernel in a few weeks
 - New version every 3 months

Distro Specific Aspect

- Bluecurve
 - Ease of use for End user
 - Custom/themes
- Rpm preferred
- /etc/init.d

Package Management

- Source
- Rpm's
- Apt-get / Yum
- Easy of installation with many choices

What can we expect?

- Easy of install
- Ease of Use
- Ease of keeping
 - Apt-get update && apt-get upgrade

Choosing Fedora

- Goal of Deployment to all CCS
 - Ease of everything for new user
 - Transition
- **NEU Fedora Server**
 - Development as new Crew Project
 - New packages
 - NEU's and Crew's reputation grows
 - If not Fedora Server (Debian or Gentoo)

What's New and Cool?

- Apt-get II Yum
- Gnome 2.4
- 2.6 Kernel Implemented

What do I dislike?

- Early Stages the Project
 - Not enough difference from Redhat
 - Doesn't have a fully developed community base
- Doesn't incorporate wineX or crossoveroffice
 - Ex SuSe and Xandros
