THE NEW GROUP OF WORLD SERVERS

Creative people from all parts of the world serving in all fields of human endeavour are subjectively linked by the quality of their thoughts and actions; collectively they are known as the "new group of world servers". Above all members of this group represent an inclusive attitude of mind and the purpose underlying their life and activity is that of world service.

Their work is primarily, therefore, that of education and the expansion of human consciousness. Through the impression and expression of certain spiritual Ideas, they are bringing humanity to the understanding of the fundamental ideals which will inspire new modes of living. They sense the interrelationship of the microcosm with the macrocosm and the urgent need to form right relationships with all kingdoms of nature.

DECEMBER 21-28, 2005

As the consciousness of humanity expands, new spiritual energies become available for use in service. These energies follow a cyclic pattern, as does all else in nature. One such cycle has its impact on human consciousness between December 21 and 28 every seven years. The inflowing energy therefore blends with and augments that of Capricorn, which initiates humanity into greater light. We therefore invite your participation in publicising this festival week, and sounding out a strong and clear note of goodwill to answer the urgent need for the adoption of spiritual values.

VALUES TO LIVE BY

A Love of Truth - Essential for a just, inclusive and progressive society.

A Sense of Justice - Recognition of the rights and needs of all.

A Spirit of Cooperation - Based on the principle of right human relationships.

A Sense of Personal Responsibility - For group, community and national affairs.

Serving the Common Good - through the sacrifice of selfishness. Only what is good for all is good for each one.

These are spiritual values, inspiring the conscience and the consciousness of those who serve to create a better way of life. The human and world crisis of today is basically spiritual, testing the character and intention of all people. This provides opportunity to re-appraise the values we accept as a personal standard of behaviour, and that of the world society as it attempts to meet its many challenges.

During 2005 we have seen initiatives such as Make Poverty History and Live 8. We have also seen how reform has become a major focus both of the United Nations and the European Union. These are attempts to test out and express the above values, particularly that of "serving the Common Good". We see that, while self-interest is uppermost, there can be no "social harmony", no security or unity, no freedom or well-being. Perhaps the next seven years will see "the sacrifice of selfishness" coming into its own as people of goodwill recognise the need for sharing and the contribution of all parts of society towards the growth and prosperity of the whole. The word sacrifice means "to make whole", and is therefore closely linked to the expression of synthesis and goodwill by the new group of world servers.
