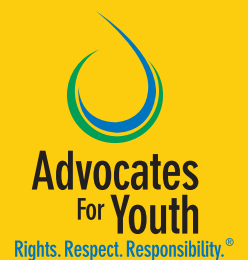

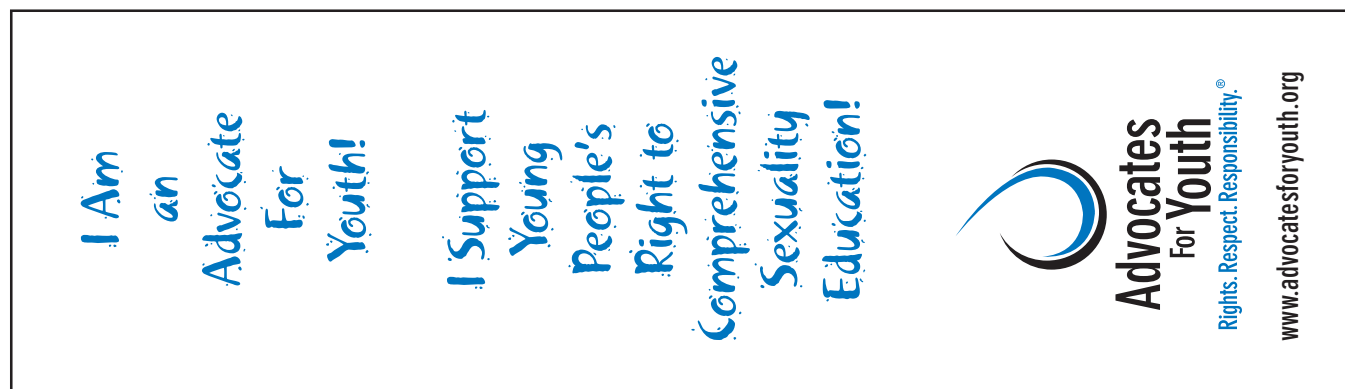
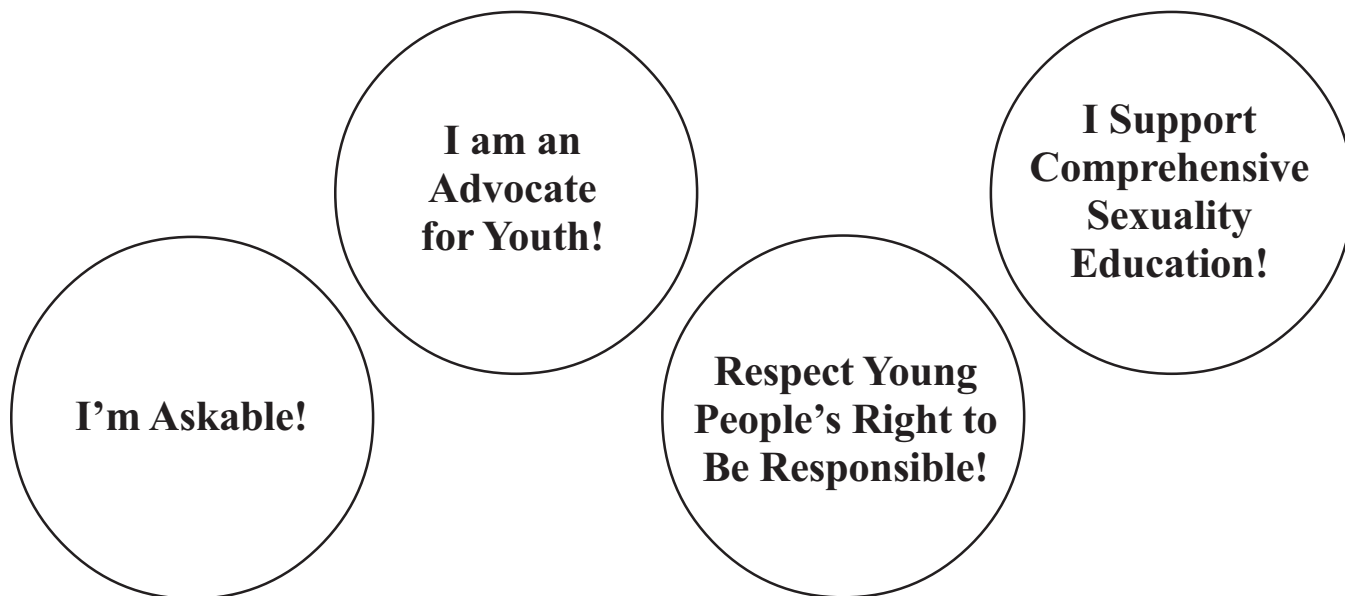

- ❖ **Rights:** Young people have rights to balanced, accurate, and realistic sexuality education and confidential and affordable sexual health services.
- ❖ **Respect:** Youth deserve respect. Society too often perceives young people means simply as a set of risk factors to be managed and controlled. We need to make the case for youth as assets, involving them the research, development, and implementation programs and policies that will shape their lives.
- ❖ **Responsibility:** Young people can act responsibly, make the link between sexuality and values, and protect their own health and that of others. But, responsibility is a two-way street.
