Last week one of the men I work with, Julian, and I met with a student named Che' from Lebanon. Julian had noticed that Che' had come to our Wednesday morning prayer meeting and had set up an appointment with Che' in order to find out more about him. We found that Che' was very hungry for God but didn't know where to look so he thought a prayer meeting would help. Julian shared the Gospel with Che' and Che' responded by "opening his arms to Jesus." Since that time Che' has been meeting one of Julian's disciples for follow-up in order to learn how to grow in his new relationship with Christ.

It's so wonderful to see the students we work with begin to move out and have ministries of their own. Last week, Glenn, another one of the guys I work with, met a guy he used to know in high school. Glenn shared Christ with him and he trusted Christ. They have been meeting for follow-up since. Julian also saw Rodney, a guy who has been hanging around Crusade for a while, put his trust in Christ Thursday morning.

Glenn's desire is to help a group of fellow students grow in Christ and has decided that in order to see this happen he is going to have to see a bunch of students become Christians. So he has decided to pass out questionnaires in 20 or so classrooms to see if anyone is interested in having a relationship with Christ. It is that kind of pure desire that God honors.

Paige, one of Valerie's women, also desires to help others grow in Christ and so will be working with Glenn in order to handle the women who surface. Lorna is also making strides to be used in personal discipleship.

Please pray for the Gospel to go forth here, especially in the dorms. A fellow staff member and I had a chance to address the resident advisors in Foley Hall about us putting together a program for the dorm with the Gospel in it. We have the OK from the dorm director but need the approval of individual resident advisors to go ahead.

Please pray also for roads into the black community here on campus. Julian has a meeting next week with a past president of the Black Student Assosiation and we hope to put together an evangelistic program for the BSA using a prominent businessman. Valerie also has a key meeting next week with a black women in order to share Christ.

Please pray also for Valerie next week as she meets with the chair of the home economics department to discuss the possibility of presenting evangelistic meetings in home ec classrooms. I would appreciate your prayers for me as well as I seek to do the same in business classes.

Please join us in prayer also for the Fall Conference. I ask that you would ask God to raise up students to attend this strategic conference and that He would use it to raise the commitment level of our students. I would appreciate your prayers as well because I'll be MCing this Northern California-wide event.

We appreciate you greatly. You are having an impact in the lives and direction of these college students. Thank you so very much.
