WHAT'S NEW IN QUEST MIGRATION MANAGER FOR EXCHANGE 4.1

Quest Migration Manager for Exchange is the Quest product for Exchange 2000/2003 migrations and reconfigurations. This document lists the major new features and improvements introduced in this release compared to version 4.0.

The topics below describe only the main new functionality. For more information, see the product User's Guide and other documentation.

Improved Setup and Configuration

Migration Manager now features an Express setup that allows automated installation of all components and required redistributables with a simple setup wizard. If you choose this option, you do not have to do any project configuration. After installation, simply select domains and Exchange servers, and start the migration.

Should you need to reconfigure the product, you can do so easily with the Open Project Wizard. This single wizard is now capable of configuring all migration components: AD migration, Exchange migration, database connections, and Statistics Portal.

Multi-Node Cluster Support

Both source and target servers can now be virtual servers running on any cluster configuration. This applies to both mailbox and public folder servers. The console automatically detects clusters and sets up the agents appropriately. Should the cluster failover, the agents will failover appropriately.

The only exception is two active virtual Exchange servers running on one physical node. Failover to such configurations is not supported and customers are advised not to use such a configuration.

Improved Migration of Remote Users

Migration of remote users collections has become even better: users in these collections are no longer forced to log off. Instead, the tool waits for each user to log off and then performs the switch.

And Migration Manager is still the only product on the market capable of preserving offline and cached profiles without content resynchronization for all Outlook, Windows, and Exchange versions.

Globalized User-Interface

Migration Manager is now capable of migrating any localized version of Active Directory and Exchange. The tool will show and handle correctly any characters supported by these platforms.

Automated RPC over HTTP Deployment

If the target environment has Exchange 2003 RPC over HTTP deployed, Migration Manager can now automatically switch Outlook profiles into this mode during the profile update. This dramatically reduces the effort required to deploy this new Exchange feature to desktops throughout the network.

UPGRADING FROM VERSION 4.0

Even if you have already started migration with Migration Manager for Exchange 4.0, you can upgrade to version 4.1. All configuration settings will be preserved and you can continue the project.
