Immigration is about the economy, national security and families.

We need reform that:

Today's immigration system does not meet the needs of our economy and forces workers and employers into the underground economy. Unworkable immigration laws threaten our security by keeping more than 10 million undocumented immigrants in the shadows, without official record. This outdated immigration system does not provide a way for immigrants to get in line for citizenship, and only serves to tear apart families.

- Recognizes that our economy is strengthened by immigrant workers.
- Recognizes that creating legal paths for employers to meet labor shortages can also enhance our border security.
- Enables undocumented immigrants to work and earn a path to citizenship.
- Keeps families together.
- Protects all workers regardless of their immigration status.
- Protects and restores basic rights and liberties.
- Allows young immigrants to reach their full potential through equal access to college.

The Secure America and Orderly Immigration Act of 2005 can be a starting point.

The Secure America and Orderly Immigration Act of 2005 has opened a new and more thoughtful dialogue about our immigration system. Unlike other proposals that treat immigrants like criminals, or that are narrowly and unrealistically focused on enforcement, this bipartisan proposal introduced by Senators John McCain (R-AZ) and Edward Kennedy (D-MA) is a meaningful step towards reforming our immigration system. This bill deserves immediate attention and should be further strengthened into comprehensive immigration reform that is humane, realistic and just.
