The following list includes all USA cases *documented* by NCMEC, IAHSS and FBI-NCAVC concerning the **Abductions by Non-Family Members from healthcare facilities, homes, and "other places" of Newborns/Infants (birth to 6 months)**. *Definition:* Non-Family members = not parents nor legal guardians. *Comparison data:* approximately 4.3 million births in USA yearly at more than 3,500 birthing facilities.
