Minnesotans Reject Exploitation of Bridge Tragedy

Polling data reveals Minnesotans oppose gas tax increase

Washington, D.C. – In the wake of the devastating collapse of the I-35 Highway Bridge in Minnesota, some politicians have attempted to exploit this tragedy.

Before the collapsed roadway had been cleared in Minneapolis, before casualties had been confirmed and before a cause for the accident had been determined, a number of journalists and lawmakers across the country began demanding a fuel tax increase.

Immediately following the repeated calls for a gas tax hike, polling data on the favorability of such a tax increase has begun to surface. According to a poll conducted by Survey USA in coordination with KSTP-TV of Minneapolis and WDIO-TV of Duluth, **Minnesota taxpayers do NOT favor a tax increase at this time.**

According to the poll of more than 500 residents, <u>57 percent</u> oppose a gasoline tax increase as a funding source to pay for the "improvement of roads and bridges."
