IMA-EUROPE RECEIVES MONEY FOR COMMUNITIES.

Heidelberg, GE – Installation Management Agency Europe (IMA-EUROPE) will receive a check for \$96,039 on June 15 for Family Support and Youth Programs (FSYP).

Ms. Renee Acosta, President and CEO of Global Impact, which is the Department of Defense (DoD) campaign manager for the Combined Federal Campaign Overseas (CFC-O), will present the check to Mr. Russell Hall, IMA-EURO Regional Director.

FYSP is one way that community members can contribute during the CFC-O drive with the purpose of channeling 100% the contributions back to their local communities. The funds are distributed to the installation of origin and are used to support quality of life programs for service members, DoD civilians and their families.
