BY CAR

From Nice:

- Motorway or “La Moyenne Corniche”: On arrival at the “Place du Jardin Exotique” (western entry to Monaco), follow directions for “Fontvieille – Palais Musée” and then “Centre Commercial”.
- Cap d’Ail coastal route: Follow directions for “Fontvieille
- Palais Musée” until the mini-tunnel at the “Place du Canton”. At the mini-tunnel exit, turn right after the traffic lights; follow directions for “Fontvieille Centre Commercial”. At the roundabout, turn left into the “Parking Stade Louis II”.

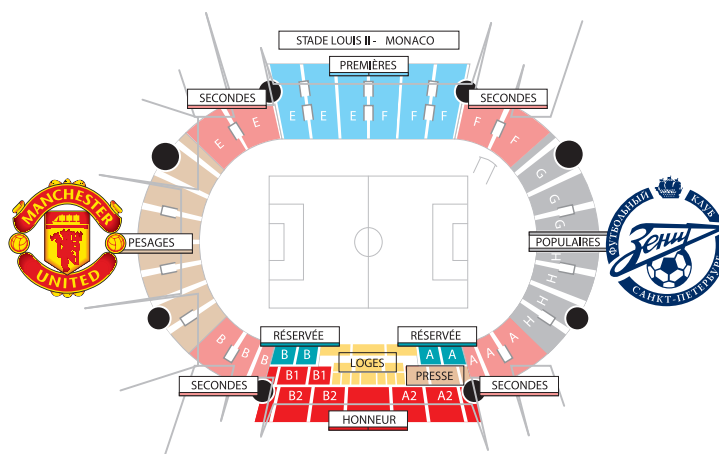
RULES OF PROCEDURE

- Each spectator, adult or child, must be in possession of a valid ticket to access the stadium.
- The ticket-holder must respect the terms and conditions of sale.
- The location of your seat is indicated by the colour and stand name on your ticket.

- All spectators will be searched at the stadium entrances by security stewards.
- To avoid spectator congestion shortly before kick-off, please go to your seat as early as possible.
- Stade Louis II is an all-seater stadium. Consequently, for safety reasons, all spectators must remain in their allotted seats for the entire game.
- It is strictly forbidden to enter the field of play or other areas which are out of bounds to the public.
- Please follow any instructions issued over the stadium PA system or on the videoboard.
- Spectators who behave in an improper manner will be ejected from the stadium.
- No duplicate tickets will be issued in the event of a ticket being lost or stolen.

IT IS STRICTLY FORBIDDEN TO TAKE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS OR OBJECTS INTO STADE LOUIS II:

- Flags, signs, emblems or placards with slogans and/or pictures which could provoke or instigate violence and/or racism
Large flagpoles, large umbrellas, musical instruments or megaphones
- Weapons and missiles
- Alcoholic beverages
- Fireworks, bangers and smoke bombs
- Anyone under the influence of alcohol and/or drugs will be refused entry to the stadium. Failure to observe these instructions will lead to prosecution.
