Tournament Registration

Player registration will occur at the Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME U.S. National Championship registration desk outside of Breakout Rooms 130–145 from 3:00 PM–8:00 PM on Friday, June 20, 2008. Late registration will occur at the Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME U.S. National Championship stage in Ballrooms 1-3 from 8:00 AM–9:30 AM on Saturday, June 21, 2008. Each player must have a valid UDE number, a government- or school-issued ID, and proof of U.S. residence to participate in the Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME U.S. National Championship 2008.

Players will have the opportunity to ask rules questions during registration. Rules questions **will not** be answered during the player meeting.

To register, each competitor must present the following information:

- UDE number
- Picture ID: All players must present a government- or school-issued picture ID to play in the Yu-Gi-Oh! U.S. National Championship.
- Proof of U.S. residence:
 - State or federal ID
 - o School ID with picture
 - o Utility bill with player's or parent's name

Tournament Information

Format

- The Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME US. National Championship will use the Advanced Format.
- This tournament will use the current Forbidden and Limited List.

Round Length

- Each round on Day 1 will be 40-minutes long.
- On Day 2, the round of 16, quarterfinals and semifinals will be 90-minutes long each, and the finals will be 120 minutes long.

Advancement

• The Top 16 players after all rounds are completed on Saturday will advance to Day 2 (Sunday).

Sporting Conduct and Professionalism

- The promotion of sporting conduct and professionalism is a high priority at the Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME U.S. National Championship.
- Participants in the Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME U.S. National Championship are expected to behave in a mature, professional, and sporting manner at all times before, during, and after the tournament.
- Participants in the Yu-Gi-Oh! TRADING CARD GAME U.S. National Championship are expected to dress in an appropriate and professional manner.

Decklists and Other Forms

- Decklists for the event will be collected at the tables at 10:00 AM during the player meeting on Saturday. Players should double-check their decklists before turning them in. Decklists must be complete and accurate when they are collected.

Players should always be careful to make sure that sleeves are not marked in any way.

- Place in the Top 4 of Regional Tournament between June 24, 2007, and June 2, 2008.
- Place in the Top 8 of Shonen Jump Championship between June 24, 2007, and June 2, 2008.
- Be in the Top 100 ranked players in the United States by June 2, 2008. Invitations awarded based on ranking DO NOT pass down.

Side Events

Advanced Format Tournament (Winner Qualifies for U.S. Nationals)

At 9:00 AM on Friday, June 20, registration will begin for 32-player Advanced Format Tournaments. Sign-ups will remain open until 8:00 PM and will launch the tournaments as soon as 32 people register. Entry fee is \$15 per tournament.

The tournaments will be run as single elimination, best two-of-three games with a 40-minute time limit. The winning player from each tournament will receive an invitation to participate in the U.S. National Championship the next day. Booster pack prizes will be given out to the Top 4 finishers.

Players who are already qualified for the U.S. National Championship *may not* compete in Advanced Format Tournament (Winner Qualifies for Nationals) events. A qualified player who participates in the Advanced Format Tournament (Winner Qualifies for Nationals) events will be considered to have forfeited their invitation and will need to win his or her tournament to participate in the U.S. National Championship.
