I am writing to inform you that the second draft of the revised *Operational Guidelines* for the Implementation of the World Heritage Convention has been completed and comprises amendments agreed to by the Drafting Group who met at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris, France from 8 to 12 October 2001.

The report of the Drafting Group (WHC-01/CONF.208/6) which includes the second draft of the revised Operational Guidelines in Annex IV, was noted by the twenty-fifth session of the World Heritage Committee in Helsinki, Finland in December 2001. At the session, the Committee decided that the next meeting of the Drafting Group will be held at UNESCO Headquarters in Paris, France from 18 to 22 March 2002 to review the Annexes and sections of the *Operational Guidelines* still requiring finalization.

The second draft of the revised Operational Guidelines is accessible for your review and comment in electronic form on the World Heritage Centre's web site (www.unesco.org/whc/opgu/).
