# **Delta Vision Process Proposal**

**Draft March 14, 2006** 

## **Purpose and Outcomes**

- **Describe a "Current Trends 2100 Delta" Scenario** to identify the risks of continuing the current uses and resource management practices in the Delta on its ecosystem, infrastructure, water conveyance and quality, and local and state economies, in light of changing environmental, hydrologic, seismic, climatic, and land use conditions.
- **Develop a long-term strategic Delta vision** for the multiple uses, resources and ecosystem in cooperation with elected officials, government agencies, stakeholders, academia, and affected California communities.
- **Develop public policy and resource management options and scenarios** to achieve this strategic Delta vision.
- Prepare a near-term contingency/emergency response plan for a catastrophic event in the Delta.
- Meet the requirements of Assembly Bill 1200 (Water Code Sections 139.2 and 139.4) by January 2008.
- Inform CALFED's End-of-Stage 1 decisions in early 2008.
- Inform preparation of Delta HCP/NCCP.



It will also include recommendations for a public process suitable for the DVP within time and funding limits.	August 2006
