

## Notes:

- 1. Dig hole twice as deep as rootball and allow at least 200 mm around sides for backfilling with topsoil.
- 2. Apply fertiliser to bacfill (type & rate as specified). Avoid direct contact with roots.
- 3. Place plant in centre of hole, backfill with approved topsoil, firming progressively. Ensure that soil level does not exceed base of tree stem.
- 4. Water well into saucer around crown of plant.
- 5. Stake larger shrubs where necessary, using  $50 \times 50 \times 1200$  mm hardwood stakes.
