POSITION ON THE PROPOSED DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES POLICIES FOR NAMING DEPARTMENT-ADMINISTERED LANDS AND FACILITIES AND PRIVATE SECTOR PARTNERSHIPS AND DONATIONS

ADOPTED MARCH 28, 2007

WHEREAS, the Department of Natural Resources (Department) has drafted a recognition policy to meet the requirements of previously adopted legislation, 2006 PA 248; and

WHEREAS, the Department has over 4.5 million acres of land and numerous facilities; and

WHEREAS, to effectively gain valuable donations and partnerships while maintaining the long-term conservation integrity of the state lands and facilities, a new policy has been drafted based upon research of other states and governmental entities and past Department practices; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Commission reviewed the draft policy at their January 2007 meeting, has invited public comment on the draft policy and will act on the proposal at a future meeting.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Citizens Committee for Michigan State Parks recommends the Department Director and the Natural Resources Commission adopt the proposed policies for naming Department-administered lands and private sector partnerships and donations as they encourage valuable donations and partnerships while maintaining the long-term conservation integrity of state lands and facilities.
