## RESOLUTION TO OPPOSE TAKING OF MICHIGAN CIVILIAN CONSERVATION CORPS TRUST FUND FOR 2007 STATE BUDGET BALANCING PURPOSES

## **ADOPTED JUNE 13, 2007**

WHEREAS, interest income from the Michigan Civilian Conservation Corps (MCCC) Trust Fund has allowed the Department of Natural Resources to annually leverage at least \$1 million in total dollars, to use for a wide range of programs throughout the department, and particularly to maintain Michigan state parks; and

**WHEREAS**, the MCCC program has provided outstanding employment for young persons of high caliber; and

**WHEREAS**, loss of these dollars would dramatically and critically diminish natural resource stewardship activities, including control of invasive species on state natural areas; and

**WHEREAS**, these dollars support the only programs that serve to repair and restore damaged natural landscapes, using native plants raised at state prisons; and

**WHEREAS**, these dollars serve as match to hundreds of thousands of dollars of federal grants, which will be lost.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that taking dollars from this long established, sustainable, highly valuable MCCC program for short-term budget purposes is very strongly opposed by the Citizens Committee for Michigan State Parks.
