
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## MY MOON CALENDAR

Before you try this activity, visit Hayley, Tommy and Proton in the Phases of the Moon activity at **www.wonderville.ca**. In the digital activity, Hayley shares a Cree legend related to the sun and moon, while Tommy explains why we see different parts of the moon illuminated at different times in the month.

This is an activity that you cannot do at school because it requires a night sky. Everyday for a month (or more if you want to see a pattern), **draw the Moon** that you see each night. Include the **time of observation** and the **sky conditions**. If you are unable to see the Moon due to the sky conditions, **write your prediction** of what you think you would have seen on a clear night. **Label** each of the following:

- New Moon
- · Waxing Crescent
- First Quarter
- Waxing Gibbous
- Full Moon
- Waning Gibbous
- · Last Quarter
- · Waning Crescent
