SUBJECT: August 28, 2010 Visitation and Program Modification

On Saturday, August 28, 2010, the MCC-WSRU is running a special visit event, <u>Family Visit in the Yard</u>. This event will run from 10:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m., in the Recreation Yard.

Visiting at WSRU is limited to those offenders and visitors that have signed up and been approved for the event. Visits will return to the regular visit schedule at the end of the special event. A/B visitors that were not part of the event are welcome to visit for the evening session beginning with 4:30 p.m. processing.

Offender programming at WSRU on the morning and afternoon of the event is cancelled. This includes Recreation and Volunteer programs. Offender movement will be limited to inside the living units (including dayrooms) with the exception of meals and emergencies. Both breakfast and lunch mainlines will be served in the dining halls. Serving of the lunch meal will begin at approximately 11:30 am. Unit dayrooms will remain open until 11:00 am on this day. Regular programming will resume after the 3:50 p.m. count and dinner mainline.

We are looking at how to host events of this nature in the future without having a significant impact on the rest of the population.

This information was supposed to have been posted several weeks ago, but was overlooked. I apologize for the lack of communication to the offender population. Notice has been posted on the MCC Website for visitor information and volunteers have been notified.
