

NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOPS AND HEARING

STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD WORKSHOPS AND HEARING REGARDING THE PROPOSED REGULATIONS AND WAIVER FOR ONSITE WASTEWATER TREATMENT SYSTEMS (OWTS) AND THE ASSOCIATED DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT (EIR)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) staff will hold workshops and a hearing regarding the proposed rulemaking for OWTS. These workshops are intended to solicit public input and information on the following three related items:

- Proposed amendments to Title 27 of the California Water Code (Division 5), regulating OWTS;
- 2. Statewide Waiver of Waste Discharge Requirements for Discharges from OWTS; and
- 3. Draft Environmental Impact Report for the two regulatory actions above.



COSTS

SUBMISSION OF COMMENTS

Written comments are welcomed and encouraged. Oral comments are also welcomed at any of the eleven scheduled workshops and at the hearing. However, time limitations on the oral presentations may be imposed, depending on the number of commenters and available time for their comments. For this reason, it is preferred but not required that all oral commenters summarize written comments and, to allow for more oral presentations, that oral presentations be coordinated with other similar presentations. **Written comments must be received or postmarked on or before February 9, 2009 by 12:00 noon.** Written comments are to be addressed and submitted to:
